



The third annual Rock on the Range concert festival will take place at Crew Stadium in Columbus, Ohio on May 22 and May 23, 2010. The hard rock festival attracts fans from throughout the state of Ohio as well as from out of state for a wild party event.

At last year's Rock on the Range festival, undercover police combed through Crew Stadium and the parking lots surrounding the event site looking to make arrests. Many of the arrests and citations were alcohol and drug related offenses, including underage drinking, open container, drug abuse, possession of marijuana, possession of cocaine, drug trafficking and possession of drug paraphernalia. Numerous arrests were also made for assault and disorderly conduct. Also, a number of drunk driving or DUI arrests were made, which is referred to as OVI in Ohio.

Many of the drug and alcohol related offenses are serious offenses, which carry the possibility of jail time and a mandatory driver's license suspension. Also, a DUI or OVI carries mandatory jail time as well as a mandatory driver's license suspension.
